MAYFACS SUPPORT SERVICES

MAYFACS has many services to help you should you need any additional support at any time. All requests will be treated in the strictest of confidence, and our team will do everything we can to ensure you have access to any help that you need - be it financial, personal, social or medical.

MAYFACS Hardship Fund You may be finding it difficult to make ends meet following the recent pandemic and cost of living crisis, or through a change in living or family situation. If you are finding it difficult and need some extra support, and live or work within Mayfield and Five Ashes, do contact us in confidence to discuss how we can support you through our Hardship Fund or email hardshipfund@mayfacs.org.uk

Food Bank Referals We are able to make referrals for families and individuals to local foodbanks for anyone in need of this support, be it short term or longer. Parcels are created for you, and specific requests/dietary requirements can also be accommodated. Collections or deliveries to your house are both available. Anyone who wishes to donate food to the local foodbanks can do so at their local supermarkets and help support others in need.

Community Fridges Community Fridges are available at Heathfield, Hailsham and Uckfield and are open to anyone, no questions asked, to collect food as and when you need it. They are there to prevent food waste and support our environment by ensuring food goes to a home. They receive donations from supermarkets, cafes, local produce suppliers, and other generous donors, as well as the general public.

Everyday Support & Befriending Services With our incredible team of volunteers, we can support you should you need help with emergency shopping, getting to our activities, navigating other support services and agencies, as well as borrowing a wheelchair, DVD or Jigsaw! We can also organise a volunteer befriender to visit you on occasion or call for catch ups! If you need us for anything, please just get in touch, and if we can't help, we can tell you who can! We are here for everyone within our community.



MAYFIELD AND FIVE ASHES COMMUNITY CAR SERVICE

Do you need transport?

Our Community Cars can get you to medical appointments such as dentists, hospital visits and opticians.

This service is not a free service, it covers the cost of petrol for our volunteers & MAYFACS admin.

To qualify you must live in the parish boundary of Mayfield and Five Ashes.
